As the executive officers of the International Federation of Professional and Technical Engineers, a labor union representing more than 90,000 members throughout North America, we heartily endorse Noel Frame for Washington State Senate for the 36th District.

Rep. Frame has served in the state House of Representatives since 2016 and has proven herself a champion for a fair economy that works for working families across Washington.
